Dear Sir, Madam,

Your asylum application in the Netherlands has been rejected. I can understand that you would like to be given clarity as soon as possible about what will happen now. This letter sets out what you may expect from now on.

No reception

You have not been granted right of residence for the Netherlands. This means that you must leave the Netherlands. You no longer have the right to reception in an asylum seekers' residence centre. Even if you lodge an appeal against the rejection of your asylum application, you are required to leave the reception centre immediately. Only if you are registered in another EU country will you be permitted to stay at the reception centre until you are returned to that country.

Leaving the Netherlands

You are responsible for your own departure from the Netherlands. The Repatriation and Departure Service can help you in arranging your repatriation/return.

Entry Ban

An entry ban of two years will be imposed on you on your departure from the Netherlands. This means that you will not be permitted to enter the Netherlands and the whole European Union for two years afterwards. If you do however travel to the European Union within that period, then you will be fined up to a maximum of 4100 euros. If you are unable to pay the fine, then you may be placed in detention.

Detention of foreign nationals

You are obliged to depart under your own initiative. If you do not do that, then you may be detained in aliens detention. You will then be returned forcibly from detention to your country of origin.

Registration in another EU country

Were you previously registered in another EU country? Then, in principle, that country is responsible for handling your asylum application. In that case, the Netherlands will send you as soon as possible to that country.

Nuisance

From time to time asylum seekers, whether or not they have exhausted all legal means, cause a nuisance in or around the reception centres. Measures will be imposed immediately on any person who is guilty of causing a nuisance. That may involve a restraining order being imposed on you, or you may be detained in aliens detention or receive a term of imprisonment.

We trust that the information provided conforms to your requirement.
