

Answers to questions that were received before 29 November 2018.

WHAT

Q: Under article 7.d. III of the Migration and Development 2019-2022 grant policy framework the following thematic requirement is stated: "Prevention and combating of human trafficking of (irregular) migrants and support for victims of human trafficking in countries of origin, in the form of legal assistance, shelter and/or psychosocial support." Does this requirement imply that activities directed on legal, social and psychological assistance of victims of human trafficking in eligible countries (stated under D.6) may only focus on nationals of these countries?

A: No. Activities focussing on thematic III (as stated under article 7.d) may include all victims of human trafficking in a country listed under D.6. The country criterion only stated *where* an activity has to take place.
