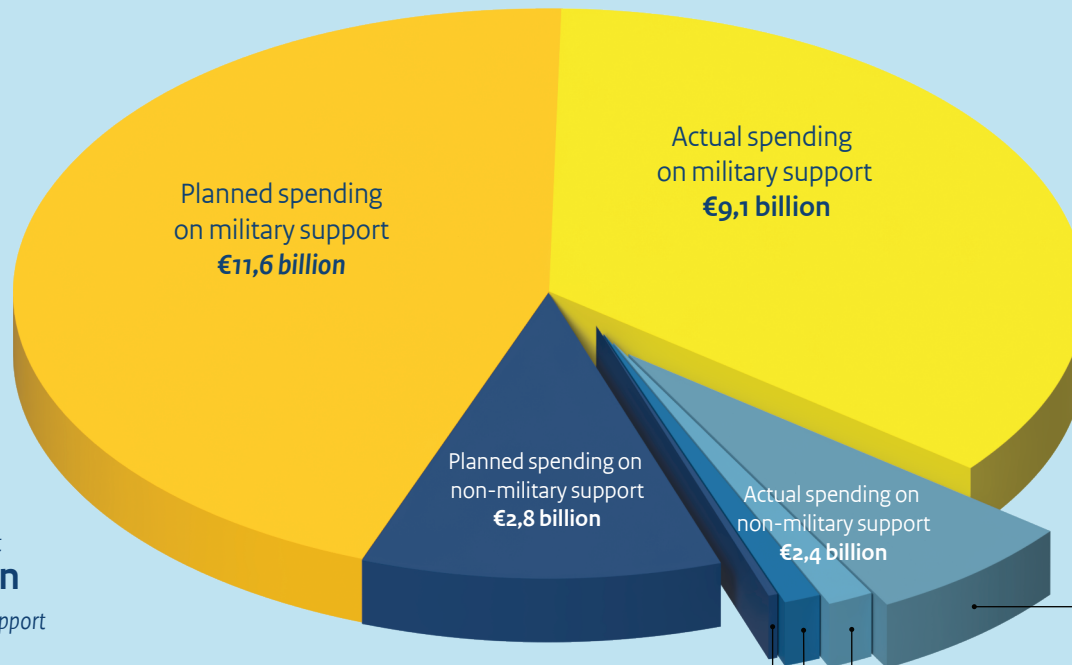
Spending in 2022–2025 and planned spending for 2026–2031 on non-military and military support

## Recovery & reconstruction 71%

To support the reconstruction of critical infrastructure, also through the private sector:

- Energy & infrastructure
- Private sector support
- European Peace Facility
- Ukraine Facility

## Budget support 13%

Financial support to the Ukrainian government to support the national budget of Ukraine.

## Humanitarian and social aid 13%

Support for:

- Food, shelter, medicines and protection for Ukrainians
- Demining
- Improved access to Mental Health and Psychosocial Support (MHPSS)

## Accountability 2%

The Netherlands is committed to prosecuting war crimes and combating impunity.

For example, by:

- The possible establishment of an aggression tribunal and a compensation mechanism.
- Supporting Ukrainian and international investigation and prosecution of war crimes.

**i** For international emergency relief we also provide unearmarked, multi-annual funding to international organizations such as OCHA, UNHCR, UNICEF and ICRC, part of which will be used to support Ukraine.
